





Background

Project Background

- Scheduled Capital Improvement Project
- Postponed from 2021 due to supply chain shortages
- Additional improvements informed by neighborhood plans



Neighborhood Plan Alignment

Oakwood, Oakland/Winchell, Parkview Hills



Improve/widen bike lanes on Parkview Avenue (All 3 plans noted)



Create safe connections between Oakwood & Oakland Winchell neighborhoods



Broadway & Parkview intersection was specifically noted to study for crossing

Planned Improvements

Water System Improvements

- Upgraded Water Main
- New Fire Hydrants
- New water service lines
- Coordinated Asset
 Management approach
 saves taxpayers money






Repaying & Restriping

- Repaved roadway from Tamsin to Oakland
- Vehicle lanes will be rightsized to calm traffic
- Using the additional road area, bike lanes will be widened

Pedestrian Improvements

- New sidewalk on north side of the road from Broadway to Barnard
- Crosswalk with a pedestrian island will be added at Barnard
- Additional sidewalk will be installed on Barnard






What to Expect

Timeline

Note: Weather and supply impacts may cause the schedule to change.

Message board signs announcing work will go up 2 weeks before work starts






Full closure between Knox & Madison

Water main replacement work. Westbound closure, eastbound remains open.





Traffic Impacts (cont.)

- Signed detour routes and message display boards will be present
- Pedestrians and bicyclists will have access to the sidewalk along Parkview Avenue for most of the work
- Traffic patterns will be monitored with Public Safety





Water Service Impacts

- There will be planned temporary water shutoffs and precautionary Boil Water Advisories (BWA) as a result of water main work
- Residents will receive a door hanger at least 48 hours prior to a planned water shut-off and will be notified when precautionary BWAs are lifted.




